Help Shape Your Neighbourhood

The Hyde Park Estate Association (HPEA), PaddingtonNow Business Improvement District (BID) and local landowners have been working together to create a Neighbourhood Area under the 2012 Localism Act.

We are now taking the step of forming a new Neighbourhood Forum. This could mean more say over the planning and development of our area through the creation of a Neighbourhood Plan, and enable us to make recommendations about the spending of the new Community Infrastructure Levy to meet local needs.

We have made very good progress. Westminster City Council has now agreed to the first step in that process – the designation of the Hyde Park and Paddington Neighbourhood Area. If you live, work, have a business or represent an organisation based in this area you will now be able to take part in the process of change, and to join the proposed Neighbourhood Forum.

On the evening of 22 March we will be joined by Stuart Woodin from AECOM who is Technical Director for Neighbourhood Planning & Engagement, assigned to us by the government as part of their Supporting Communities Programme.

Stuart will facilitate a discussion on what the neighbourhood planning process can do for this area and how you can become involved in shaping your neighbourhood. There will also be an opportunity to talk about priorities for the area and hear what can and cannot be tackled through the Neighbourhood Forum and Plan.
